Facts	What does Battle Bank do with your personal information?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include but is not limited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and income ■ Account balances and payment history ■ Transaction history and credit history
How?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information, the reasons Battle Bank chooses to share and whether you can limit this sharing.

<p>How does Battle Bank collect my personal information?</p>	<p>For example, we collect your personal information when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Open an account or deposit money ■ Pay your bills or apply for financing ■ Provide account information <p>We also collect your personal information from other companies, not affiliates or credit bureaus.</p>
<p>Why can't I limit all sharing?</p>	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
<p>What happens when I limit sharing for an account held jointly with someone else?</p>	<p>Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.</p>

Definitions	
<p>Affiliates</p>	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Battle Bank has no affiliates.</i>
<p>Nonaffiliates</p>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Battle Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so that they can market to you.</i>
<p>Joint marketing</p>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Battle Bank does not jointly market.</i>
